

Hello Riders,

Welcome the KCHoY. Thank you for your support of the first One Day Event, we hope you have an enjoyable time. Listed are things to take note of, and the timetable:

1. **ARRIVAL INSPECTION:** will be held Thursday 19th 5.00-7.00pm on the Polo grounds, Elwood Road. Make sure you have your **FEI passport**. **Medical Declarations** will need to be filled out then, or if you would prefer, you can download your own from the FEI website.
2. **FIRST HORSE INSPECTION:** will be held Friday 20th, on the Polo grounds, 2* at 9.30, followed by 3*.
3. **DRESSAGE:** Friday 20th, 2* and Novice commencing at 11.00 in the Polo grounds with the test rider
3* commencing at 4.30pm in the Main Oval premiere dressage arena with the test rider
Dressage tests for 2* & 3* are **FEI 2009 B**, available off the FEI website.
Dressage test for Novice is **ESNZ 2007 B3**, available off the ESNZ website.
Competitors dressage times may change due to scratchings or withdrawals. Please check.
4. **CROSS COUNTRY:** Saturday 21st at the HB Equestrian Park, Equestrian Lane (off Stock Rd) Hastings.
Novice at 2.00pm,
2* at 3.00pm
3* at 5.00pm
5. **THIRD HORSE INSPECTION:** Sunday 7.30am at the BMX track, 2* followed by 3*. This is at the back of the sheep pens, and next door to the secure stables.
6. **SHOWJUMPING:**
3* International arena at 11.35 am
2* National Arena at 9.00 am
Novice – Hastings Arena at 12.00 noon
7. **WINNERS PRESENTATION:** all presentations will take place in the main arena.
3* - on completion of competition
2* - 11.15 am
Novice - 1.40 pm

Elwood Road will be closed to all vehicular traffic all week. Entrance to the Showgrounds is off Kenilworth Road, Event riders use the #1 gate by the railway line. This will ensure you will be parked where you can get your vehicles in and out of the grounds.

Familiarisation: is available for 3* competitors – see attached ‘Arena Protocol’. Gayle Falconer is the steward for that arena for the entire show, has offered 7.00pm Thursday and 7.00-7.30am Friday available for riders.

No vehicular traffic will be allowed in to or out of the Park whilst cross country is in progress.
